



PROFESSION of FAITH

The Nicene Creed

We believe in one God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth, of all that exists—seen and unseen.





This Week's Sermon

This period in Jesus' ministry is not frequently discussed: the crowds recognize the plot against Jesus—that the leaders recognize him as a threat—but they're tripped up by the fact that they know him, they've been to his hometown, and he seems too normal. But the last word in the passage is a question that still rings true today: "If this isn't the Messiah, who could do any more than he has done?"

The deacons are collecting **candy** for our annual easter egg hunt. Anyone who would like to donate candy can drop it off at the church office during the week or hand it to a deacon!


You will find **Easter flower order forms** in the red friendship pads. All orders are due by the end of service today!
